

Suspected drunk driver charged after hit and run

CRIME • A man is facing charges after a hit and run on the 5th Avenue S.E. flyover that caused another car to roll over onto its roof.

The crash happened Sunday shortly after 8 p.m., when a Toyota Camry was travelling at a high rate of speed eastbound on the 5th Avenue flyover.

The Camry rear-ended a Toyota RAV4 just before Memorial Drive, causing it to roll onto its roof.

The Camry fled the

scene, running a red light at Memorial Drive.

A bylaw officer and several witnesses pursued the Camry and removed the driver from his car as he was stopped at a red light. They held him for police.

The Camry driver is now facing charges of impaired driving causing bodily harm, criminal hit and run, and driving a motor vehicle with a blood-alcohol content exceeding the legal limit.
