

Jaguar Blackmon arrested for DUI

FOOTBALL • Jacksonville Jaguars first-round draft pick receiver **Justin Blackmon** was arrested on an aggravated DUI charge Sunday after authorities in Oklahoma said he had three times the legal limit of alcohol in his system.

The former Oklahoma State star smelled of alcohol when an officer pulled him over shortly after 3 a.m., Stillwater police spokesman **Capt. Randy Dickerson** said.

Blackmon agreed to take a breathalyzer test and blew a .24 — three times the legal limit of .08, Dickerson said. Under Oklahoma law, a driver can be charged with aggravated driving under the influence when a test shows .15 or greater.

The Jaguars drafted Blackmon with the fifth pick in this year's NFL draft in the hopes that he could upgrade the league's worst offence.

"We are aware of the report and are gathering information," Jaguars spokesman **Dan Edwards** said. "We don't have any comment at this time."

Blackmon was released from jail Sunday afternoon on \$1,000 bond. He's due in court today.
